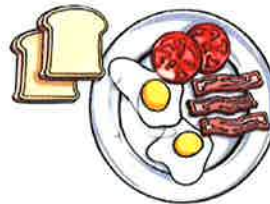

**SWEAT LODGE CEREMONY**

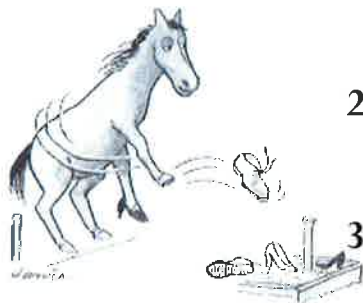

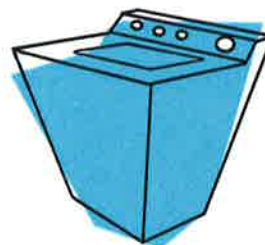
