The Student Transportation Van and Medical Vans will run on schedule.

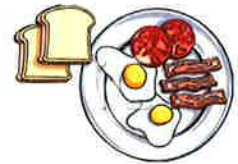

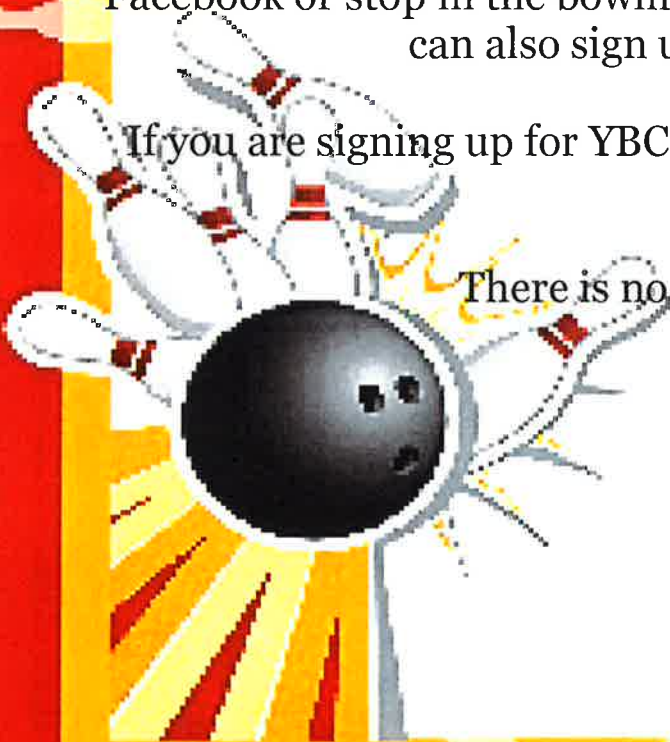
